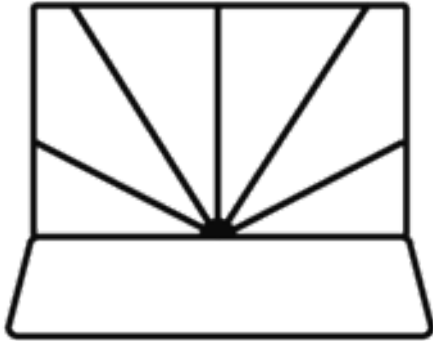

Educational platform focusing on the transformation of literature into film, based on A. Kivirähk's novel *November* and its film adaptation.

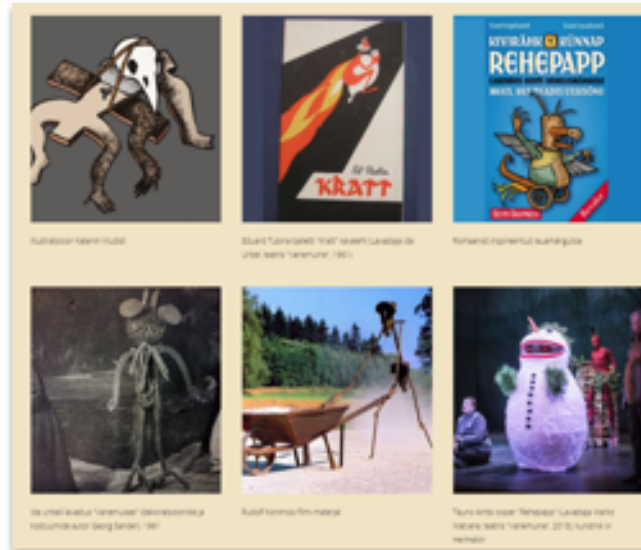

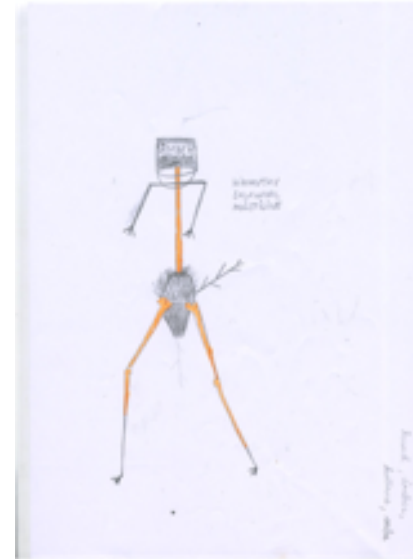
## Example 2: representations of kratt

Scene from "The little Comrade". Student's work.

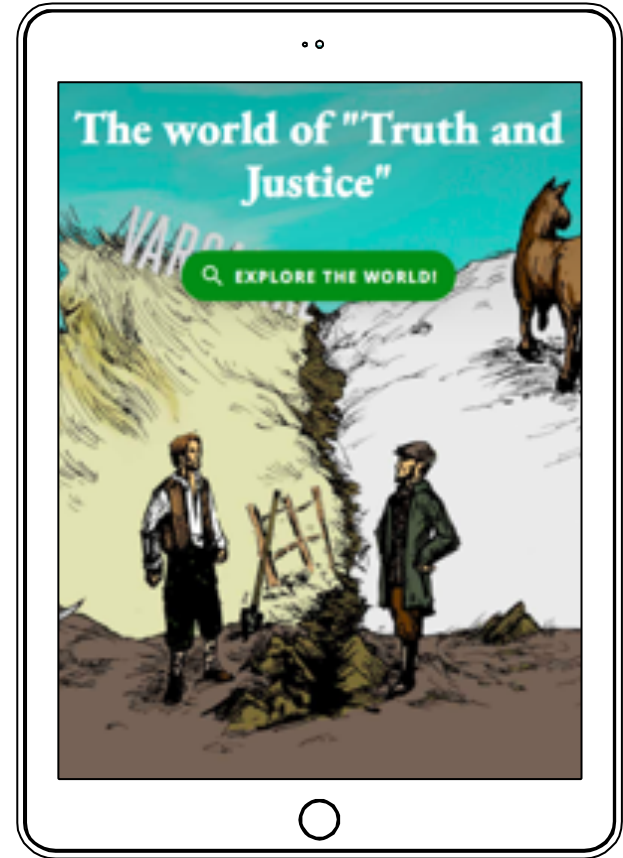
- Creating a visualisation of a scene from the script of *The Little Comrade*.

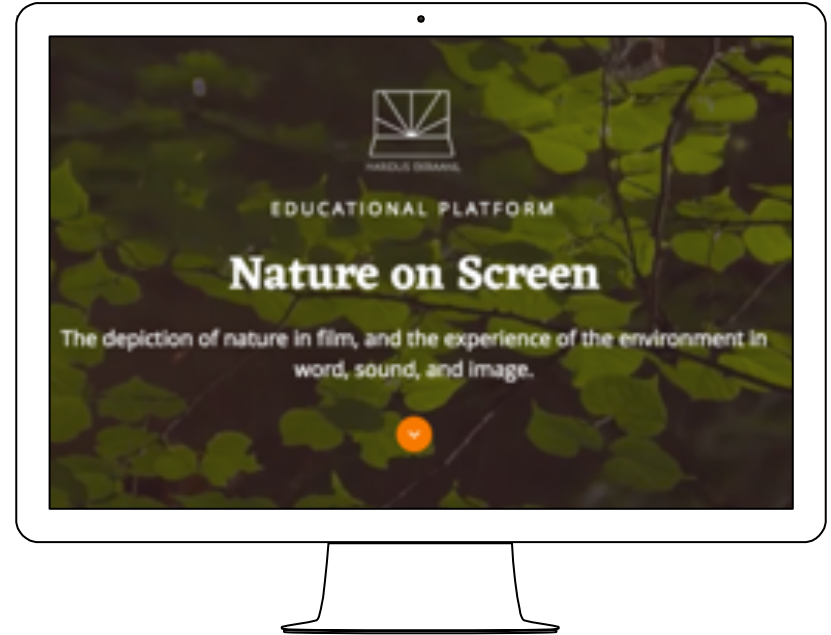




## Nature on Screen

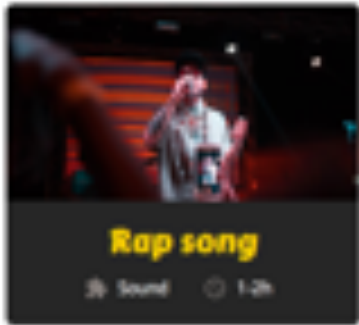
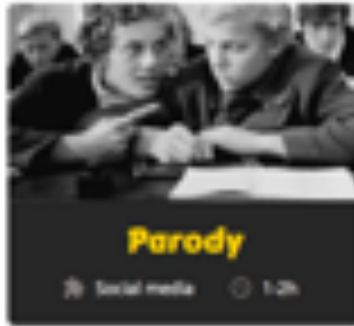
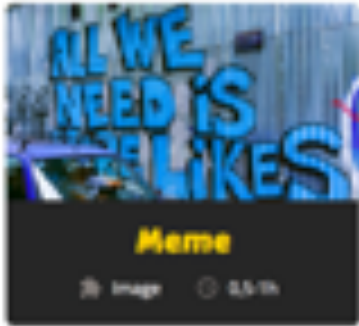
## Estonian Film Classics
