“**OER** are teaching, learning and research materials in any medium – digital or otherwise – that have been released under an open license that permits **no-cost access, use, adaptation and redistribution by others with no or limited restrictions**” (UNESCO, 2017)

- Reuse
- Revise
- Remix
- Redistribute

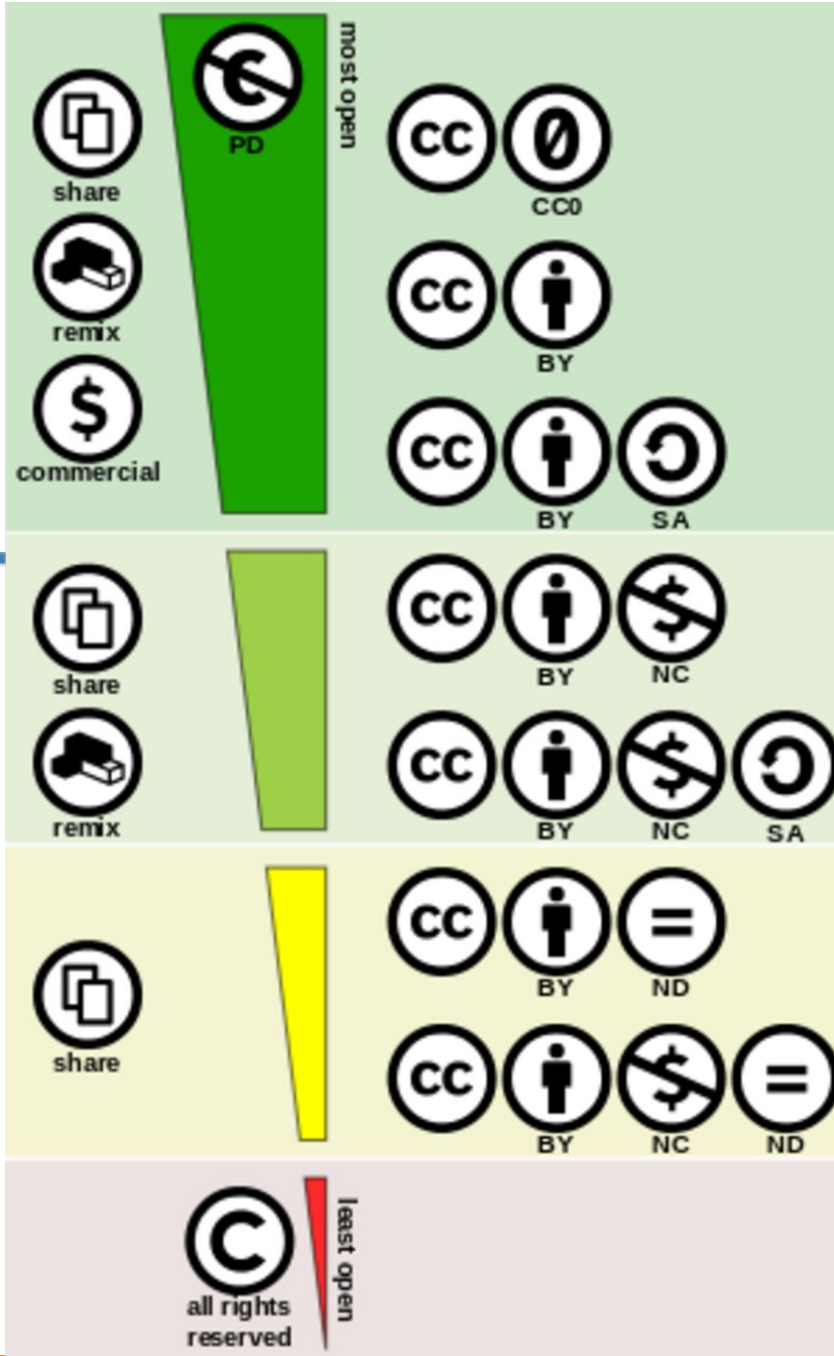
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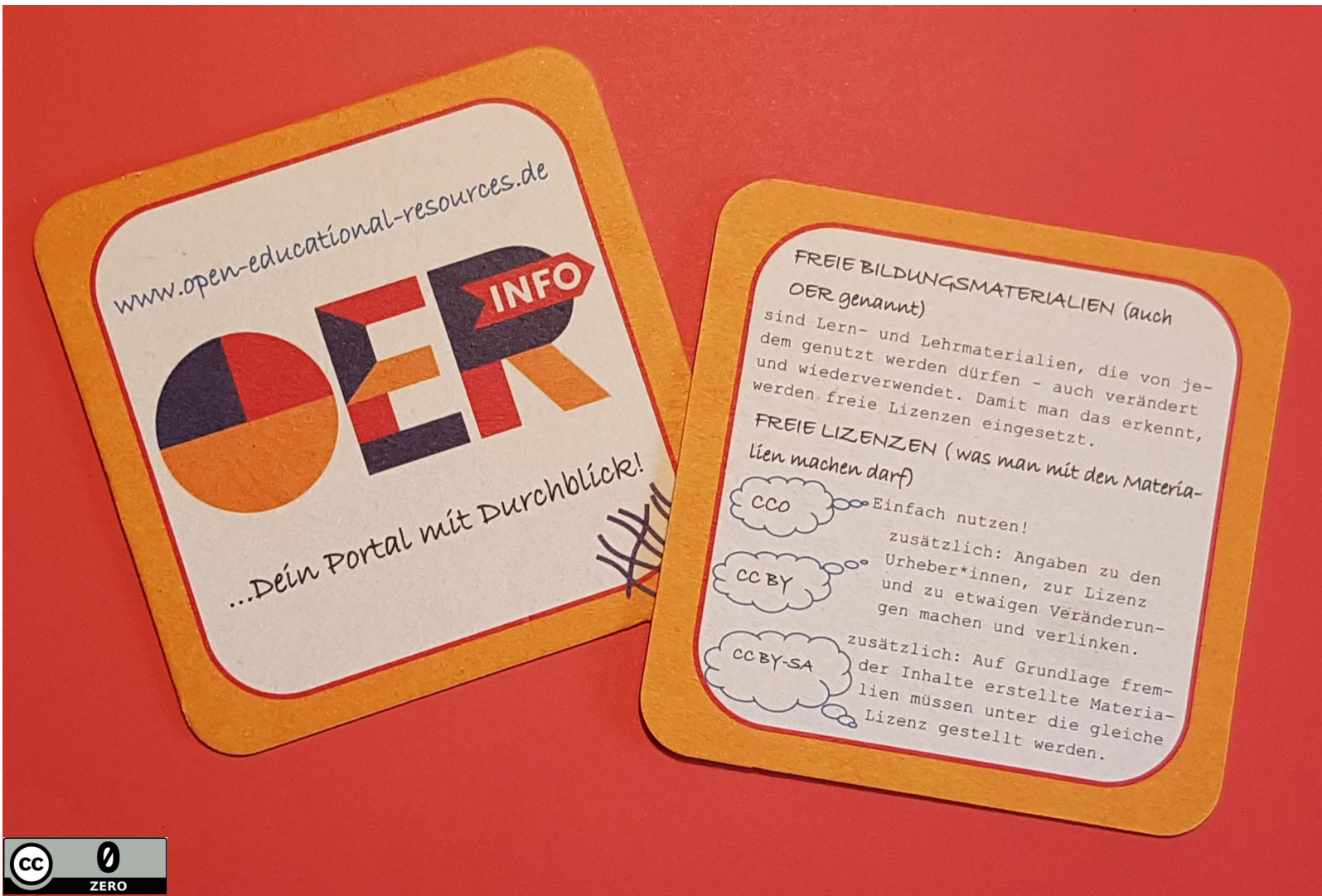

OER in Germany -

From Bottom-up to Top-down Initiatives¹

- **2011 -2013: Bottom-up initiatives:**
issues on copyright („school trojan“) -> many OER-projects, by universities, schools, foundations, crowdfunding projects
- **2012: [OECD Country Questionnaire](#):** Germany was the only country that did not expect OER issues to be a policy priority soon
- **2013:** coalition agreement (CDU, CSU, SPD); Working Group OER
- **2016 - 2018/2020: Top-down Initiatives -> OER funding program:**
24 projects in all educational sectors; [OERinfo Website](#) (till 2020) and [OERCamps](#) (till 2020)
- **2020-2021:** Covid-19 -> big push of OER and infrastructure (MUNDO)
- **2022:** still waiting for OER-strategy and further OER-funding program

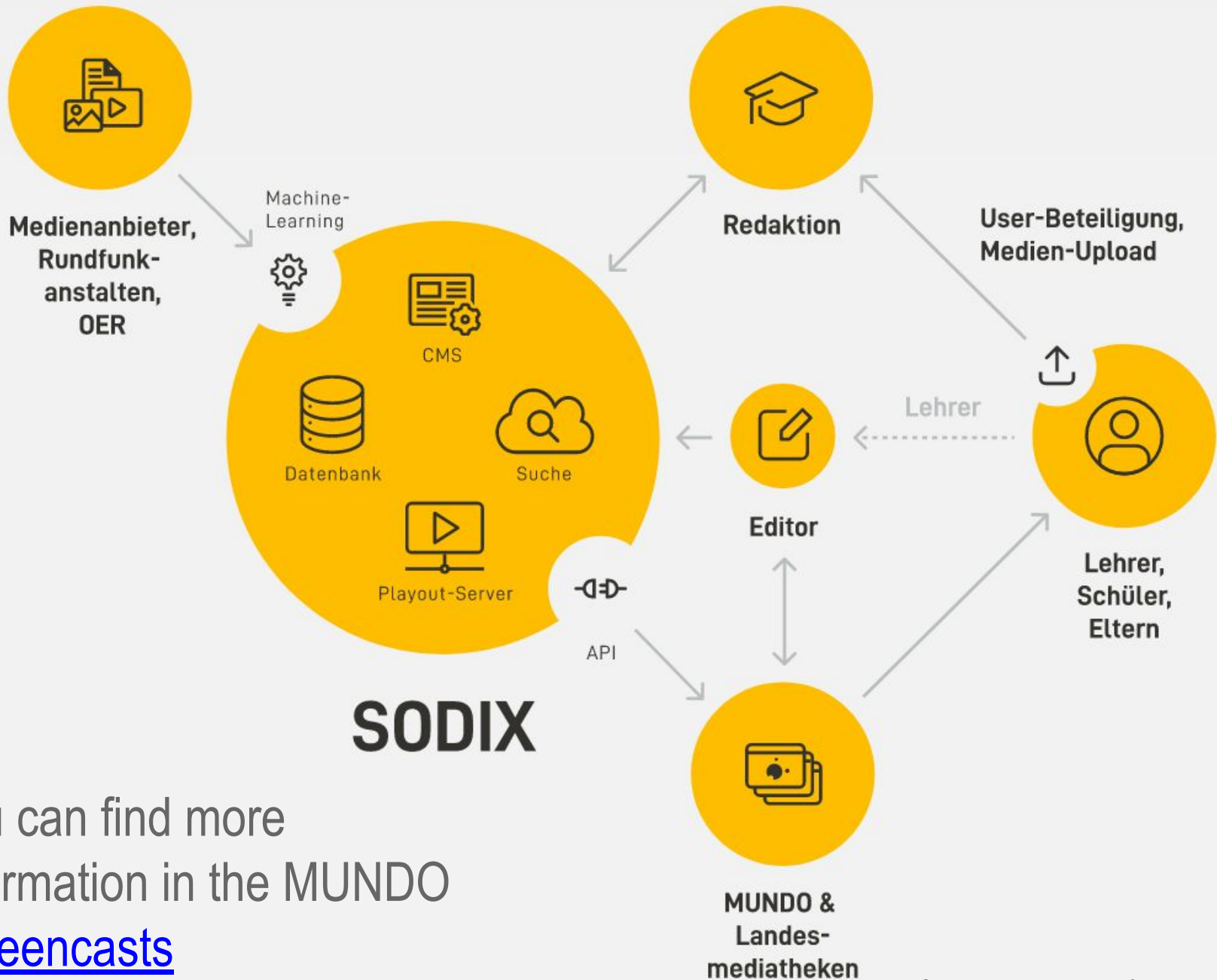

- OER are recognized for their potential in fostering innovation



- hardly any funding of content production
- no concrete plans to continue funding of OERinfo programs
- no business model for production of OER



- freely accessible [media portal](#)
- financed by the Digital Pact for Schools in Germany, online since 09/2020
- screening, testing and indexing of freely available digital media
- open access to free, reviewed and qualified material → legally secure use by teachers
- available materials are permanently stored in the portal, continuously expanded and offered to the platforms of the different countries in Germany and other third-party providers via interfaces (SODIX)






