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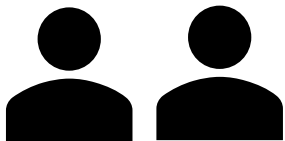
Digital Transformation in Higher Education through Active Co-creation, Training, Innovation, Open Education and Networking
