





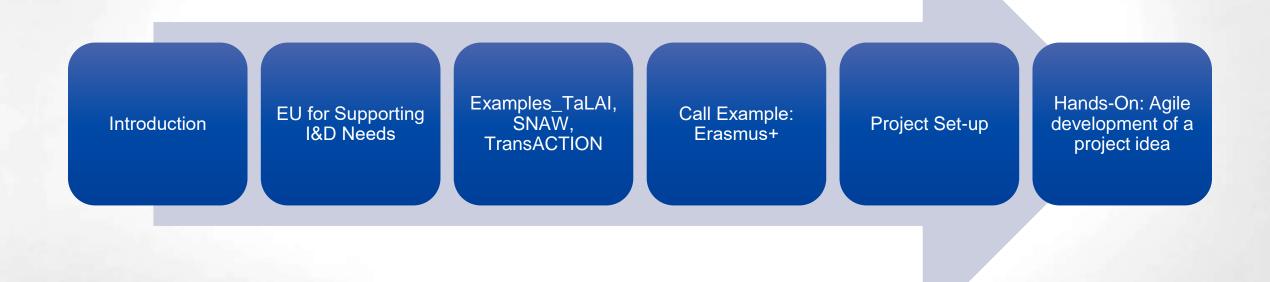

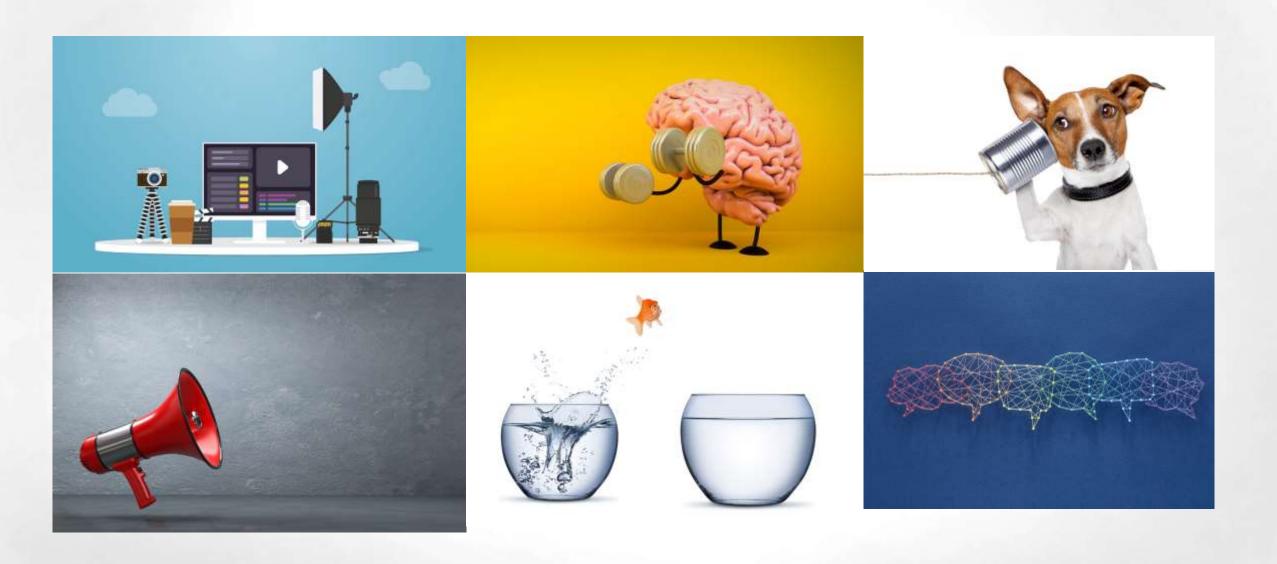

 33 Programme Countries + international activities open to the rest of the World

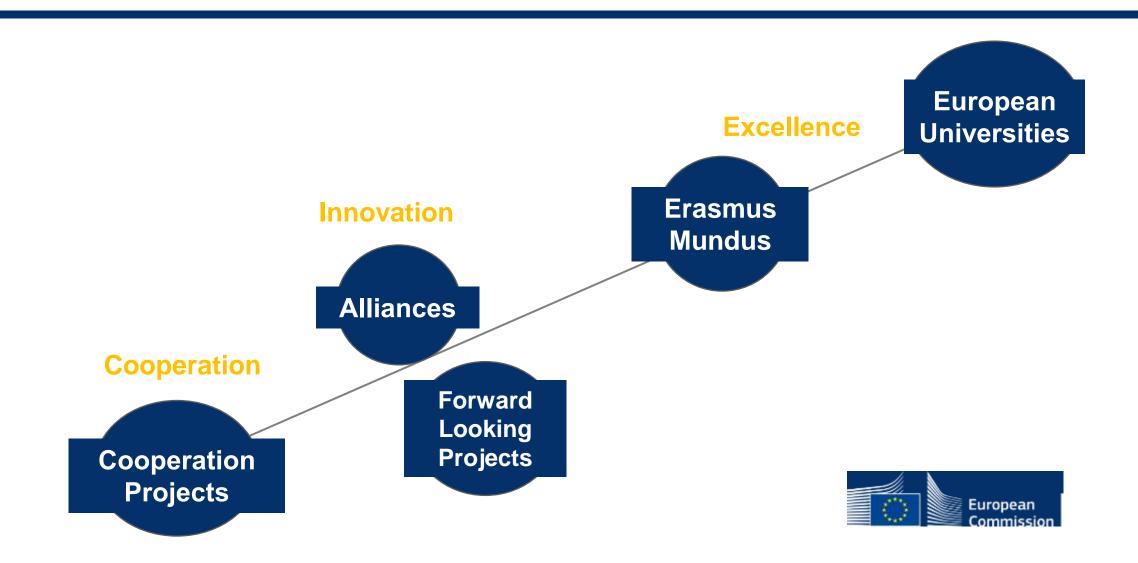

Sustainable@Work Guidelines on Organising Meetings and Events from the European Commission



The Erasmus+ call 2024 prioritized four key areas:

- 1. Inclusion and Diversity: ensuring equal opportunities, access, and fairness for all participants across its initiatives.
- 2. Digital Transformation: encouraging the development of digital skills, the use of digital tools in education and youth work, and the creation of innovative digital learning content.
- 3. Green and Digital Transitions: addressing environmental challenges and promote a smooth transition to a more digitalized society.
- 4. Participation in democratic life, common values, and civic engagement: fostering active citizenship, critical thinking, media literacy, and the importance of shared European values.



Next Call for EU Erasmus + Project Proposals is expected to be announced in November 2024 with deadline for submission in February/March 2025

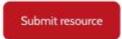

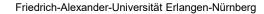

Aim:

→ Address and combat ageism in the workplace, via a digital training programme to be undertaken by employers and employees

Outcomes:

- European Research Report on Ageism in the Workplace (based on literature review and empirical research). The report will display the SNAW Framework, which in turn will inform the SNAW course curriculum
- 2. SNAW Digital Training Course (available for 3 years after the end of the project)
