Avoid when...

Moving images do not add value (in that case, consider audio-only, text or a text-based image).

Combine with...

- text and images to familiarize learners with the core concepts before they watch the video
- a voice-over, close-up images or video footage for clarity
- branching software to allow students to impact the course of the demonstration

How?

- Record software demonstrations via a Kaltura/Camtastia screencast and other standard demonstrations with a camera from the <u>lending service</u>.
- For highly complex, sensitive and/or one-shot demonstrations, contact professional production team.
- Use the tips & tricks on the <u>help platform</u>.
