

Supercampus, Spain: double winner of these MEDEA Awards 2025 ✨

The 17th annual MEDEA Awards ceremony was held on Wednesday, 18th June, at Provinciehuis, Leuven as part of the 2025 [Media & Learning Conference: Educational media that works](#), organised by the Media & Learning Association and KU Leuven. This year, the prestigious MEDEA Award was awarded to *Supercampus*, submitted by Albert Segura, 3Cat - Catalan Audiovisual Media Corporation, Spain.

Supercampus is the 3Cat [content platform](#) for primary and secondary education. It is a tool designed for the educational community with content in Catalan linked to the school curriculum and with the SX3 audiovisual quality seal. This offers free digital audiovisual material in video and podcast format with the aim of helping students in their academic training and as an educational complement for teachers and families. The contents are organised into different themes: mathematics, history...



The Special Jury Prize was awarded to *Moleculous* by Sven Graindor, [KU Leuven](#), Belgium. This is an innovative 3D visualisation tool of molecular structures. The computer application enhances the learning experience of students by giving them a better insight into complex molecular compounds, which is crucial for pharmaceutical education.

After a week of online voting with over 1,240 participants, the Audience Favourite Prize was awarded to *Supercampus*! Just like in 2023, one entry took home two awards this year!

Starting in 2025, a new thematic prize will be awarded annually. This year, the theme was Best Use of AI in Education, and the award was attributed to *Beyond Lectures: AI & XR Learning Innovations & Emphasising the Shift from Traditional Teaching Methods* presented by Andrew Parry, Imperial College Business School, United Kingdom



During the ceremony, Alberto Vasciaveo, IIS J.C. Maxwell, Italy, received a special reward for his continuous support and help as a Judge. Short clips from all 7 finalists were shown before the winners were announced. Following the announcement of the winners, the remaining finalists all received commemorative medals, they are:

- ***Counselling Skills Resource*** submitted by Walden University, United States and represented by Renee Beck.
- ***Knowbody App*** submitted by Knowbody UG and represented by Vanessa Meyer.
- ***Moda re-: A Quest to re-Store Sustainability and re-Imagine Fashion*** submitted by CIE University, Spain and represented by Elizabeth Valentine.
- ***Phonics Adventures with Zelda*** submitted by ClickView, Australia and represented by Jane Moore.
