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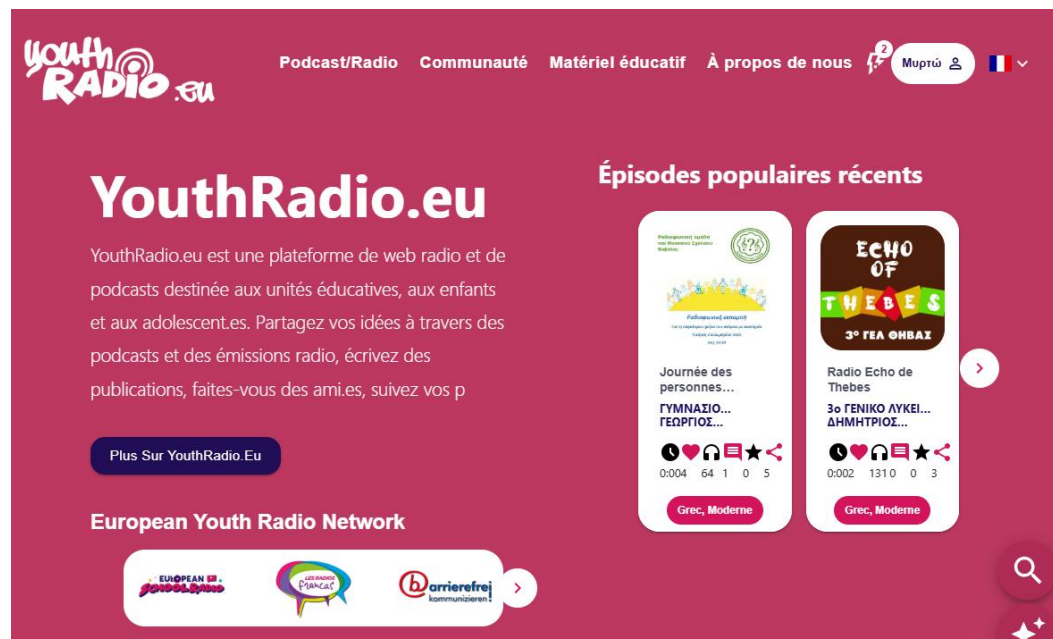
Project management

- Participation in radio and media literacy events & competitions



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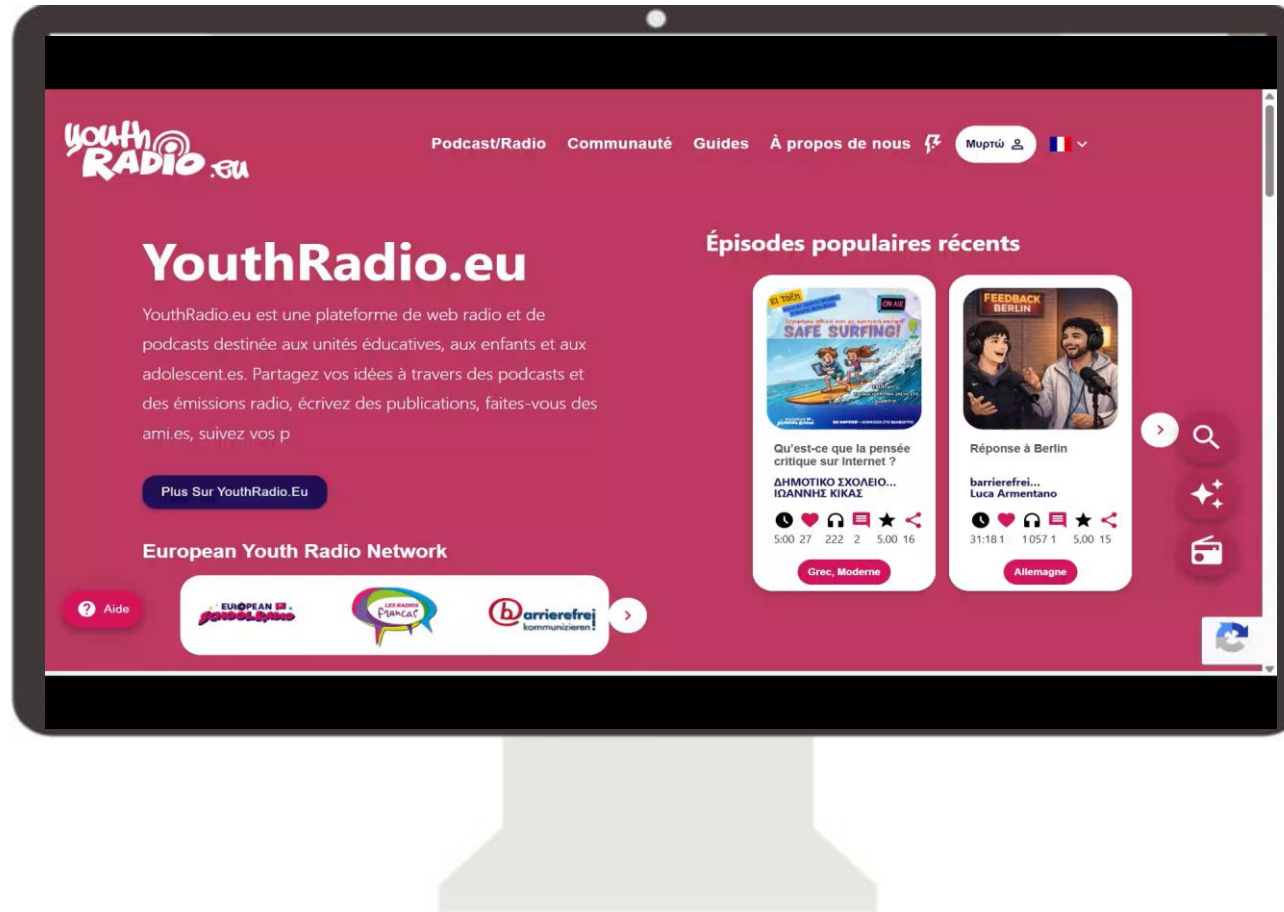
Development of innovative actions & dissemination of results

- The development of inclusive facilitation techniques for radio workshops

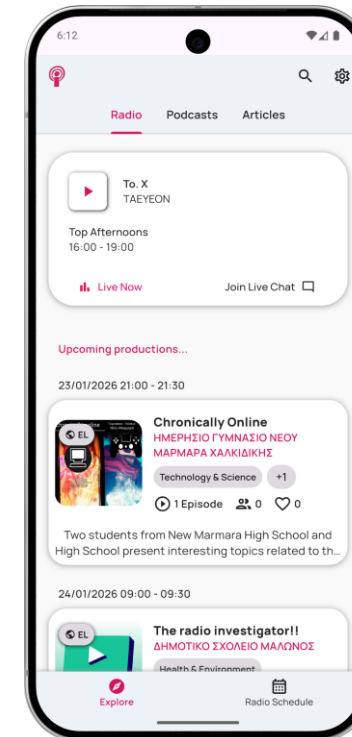

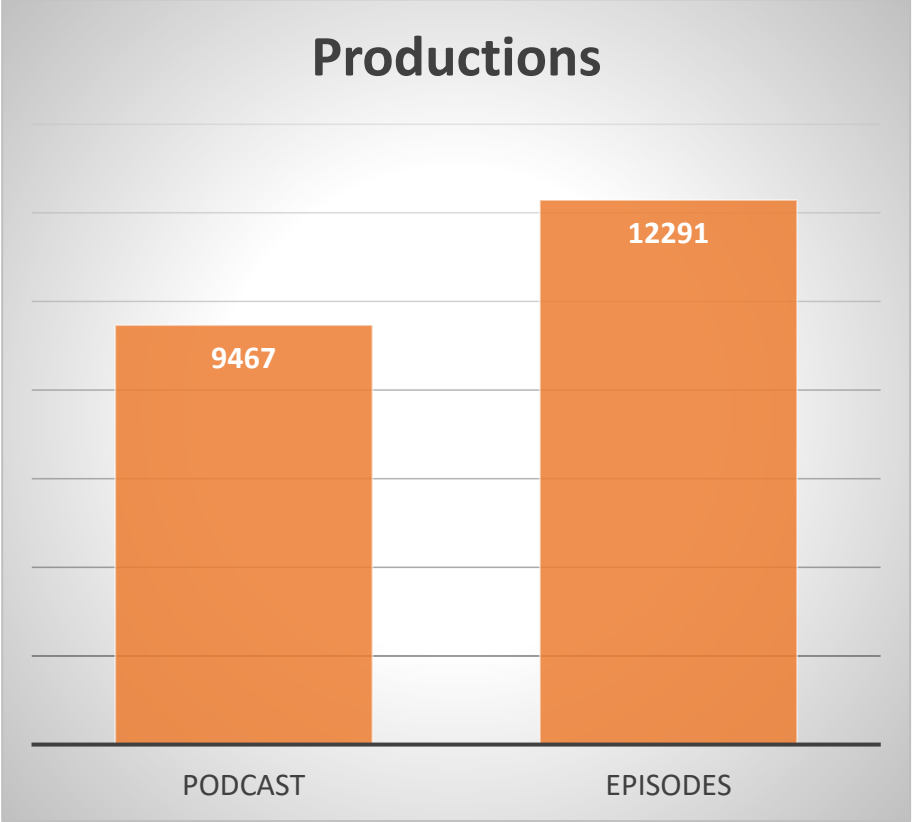
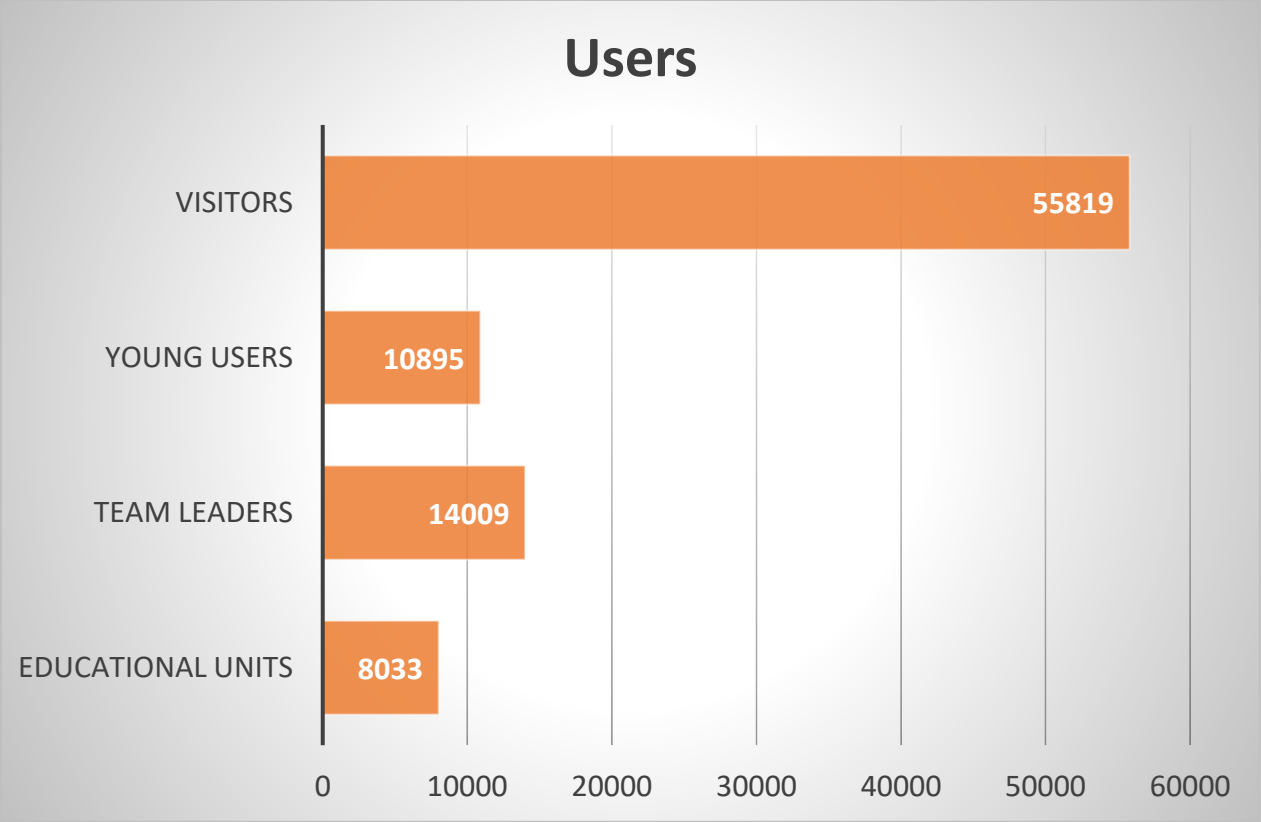

The platform in numbers

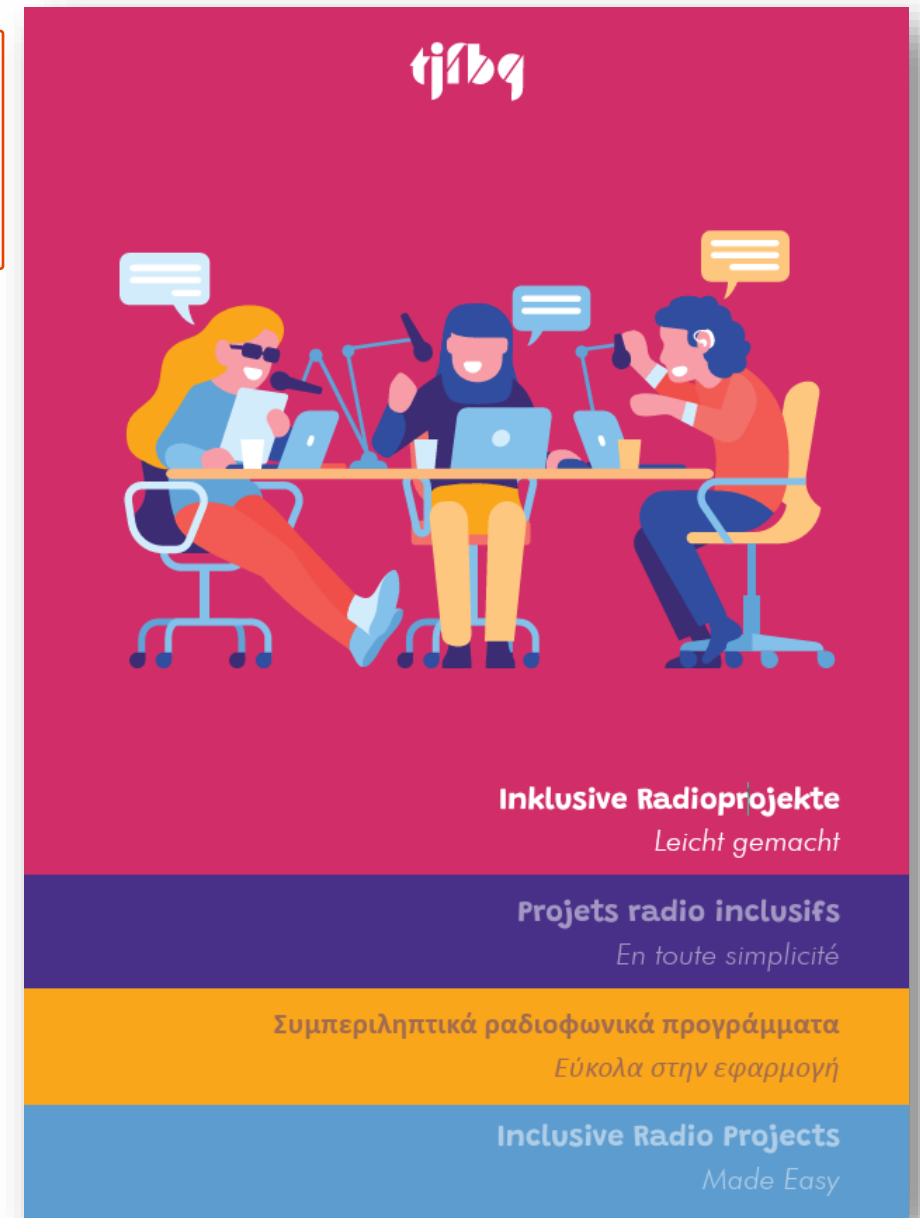
