Current Video Storage

1. Lecture Capture - Panopto
 - Production: ~100k videos = 47k hours
 - Older than 3 years, not viewed in 1 year
→
 - Archive: ~100k videos = 37k hours
 - Older than 6 years, not viewed in 4 years → Delete
2. Marketing Photos and Videos – AssetBank
 - 7 TB
 - From 2001, never archived or deleted
3. Video Production Team – File Server
 - 17 TB
 - From 2011, sometimes manually deleted

(Also not recommended)



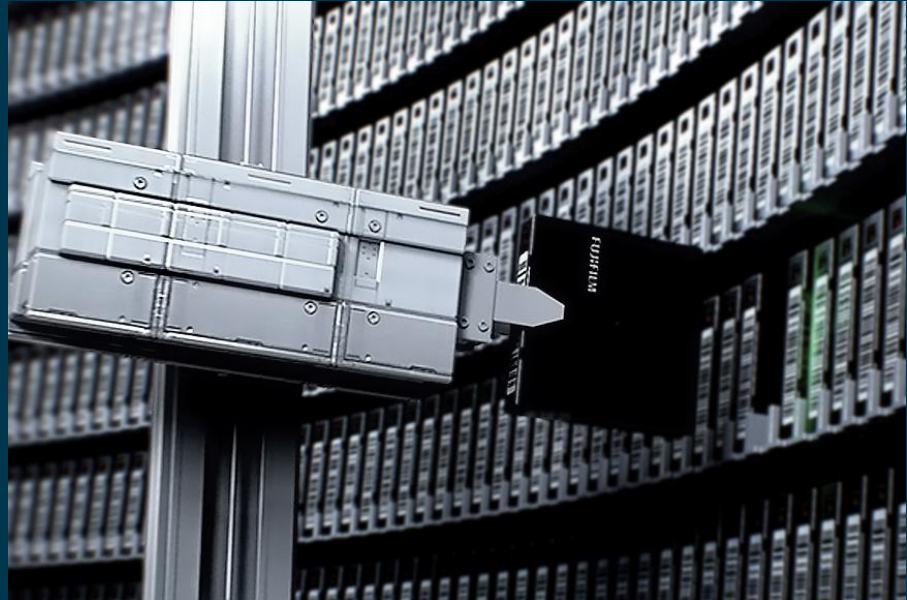

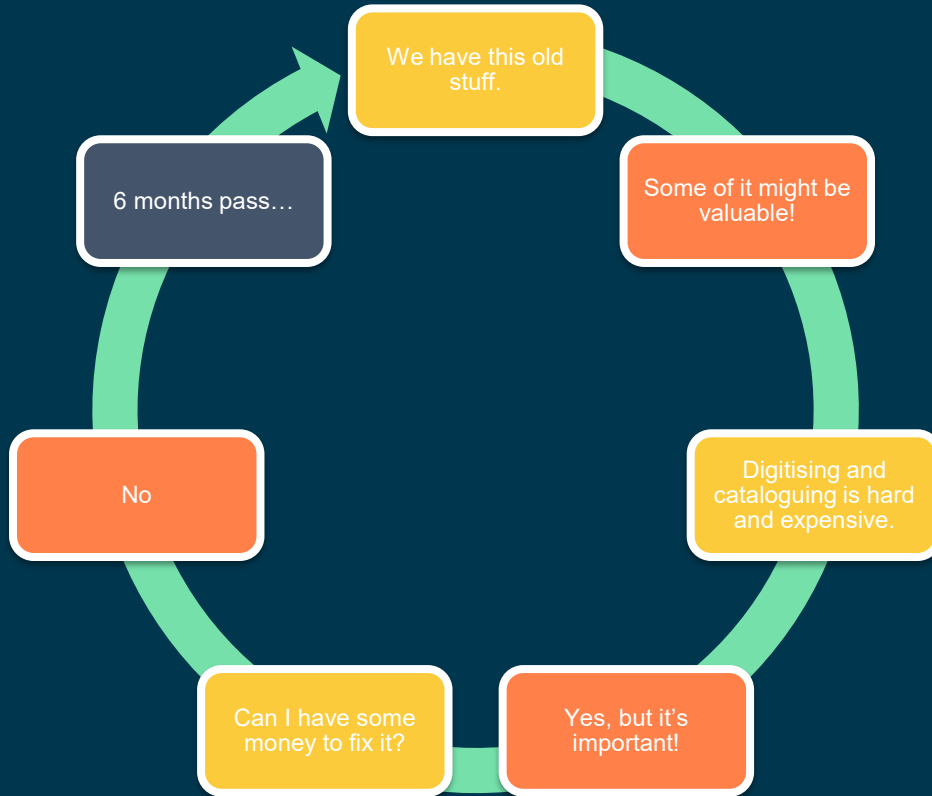
